Shipping Information For DuPont Automotive Finishes / Industrial Coatings

These descriptions pertain to shipments within the United States by highway or rail. The descriptions for air and export may differ, as products are generally not packaged for air shipments. Questions pertaining to these descriptions should be referred to Millie Ruglass at (302) 992-2699. These classifications are current as of **01/01/2011**. The following points must be kept in mind:

1. All DOT information requires that the entire DESCRIPTION be shown on the shipping paper in the sequence shown in parentheses, (i.e., UN1263,PAINT,3,PGII/III).
 - Abbreviations are NOT permitted.
 - The hazardous materials shipping paper description must be shown First (before non-hazardous materials), in a different color or highlighted, or marked with an "X" in the column marked hazardous materials.
 - ALL hazardous material descriptions must be PRINTED.
2. Packages must be marked with the SAME information as the shipping paper, (i.e., UN1263,PAINT). The red diamond label takes the place of the "3" which indicates flammable material. Limited Quantities may be marked with a diamond containing the UN number INCLUDING THE LETTERS UN.
3. You MUST identify the correct emergency response guide and ATTACH it to the shipping paper, (i.e., Guide 128).
4. You are required to list a 24-hour emergency response telephone number, which is Monitored 24 HOURS A DAY 7 DAYS A WEEK by someone who can provide product information in the event of a spill or leak.

DuPont assumes no liability for any information which may have changed or been reclassified. ***DOT regulations, 49CFR 172.700 requires that anyone who ships hazardous material, be trained in accordance with the Department of Transportation regulations. This training must be documented according to the above regulation and a certificate of training must be on file. This list does not preclude the need for training.***
